Sevilla, Spain

It will bring together experts, developers, first responders, and stakeholders to advance the development of a cutting-edge Multi-Risk Impact-Based Early Warning System (MR-IEWS), aiming to enhance real-time emergency management for weather and geo-hazard events.






The workshop offers a unique platform to explore the latest project developments, engage in collaborative discussions, showcase institutional contributions through posters, and experience live demonstrations of project prototypes tailored for pilot site implementation.

Venue

The workshop will be held at the <u>Espacio Exploraterra</u>, located in **Paseo Alcalde Marqués de Contadero, edif. 1**, on the banks of the Guadalquivir, next to the Torre del Oro. The workshop venue can be reached by bus to the stop Paseo de Colón.







How to get to Sevilla from the airport

Sevilla Airport, also known as San Pablo Airport, is located 6 miles (10 km) from the city centre. To get to your hotel, you can choose between bus (Shuttle Bus EA), or taxi.

<u>Shuttle Bus EA</u>: The "Aeropuerto Especial" is a shuttle between the airport and the centre. Buses depart from the arrivals hall of the terminal. The stops are: Avenida Kansas City, Luis de Morales, San Bernardo, Prado Bus Station of San Sebastián, Paseo de Colón, and the bus terminal Plaza de Armas.

<u>Taxi</u>: There is a flat rate for taxis from the airport to the city centre (it varies depending on the day and time).
